Changes in BiP availability reveal hypersensitivity to acute endoplasmic reticulum stress in cells expressing mutant huntingtin

The source of the parent plasmid, the BiP-169 luciferase template plasmid derived from the rat *Grp78* promoter subfragment, used to create our ERSE Td Tomato ODC reporter was incorrectly attributed.
